

General Camp Rules

- Campers are not allowed to leave the fairgrounds except for an emergency, and then only after coordination with the Camp Staff.
- Campers will be assigned to a group with a Team Leader/Counselor. Groups will sleep in a common area, near their Team Leader/Counselor.
- Campers are required to attend all scheduled activities.
- West River Rodeo Bible Camp IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR LOST OR STOLEN ARTICLES! Clearly mark all belongings with your name.
- Long-sleeved shirt, western boots, denim jeans, and a western hat will be worn while competing in the rodeo. Long-sleeved shirt, boots, and jeans may also be required to participate in learning certain activities.
- No halter or tube tops. No “spaghetti” straps or midriff showing. No low-cut, revealing tops. No “short-shorts”.
- Only those Campers that have signed all necessary documents and paid their tuition are allowed to participate and/or stay overnight at the Rodeo Bible Camp. This is due to insurance requirements.
- No dogs.
- The use of cell phones (talk-OR-text) is allowed only at specific times during the Camp. All other electronic entertainment devices are not allowed.
- Absolutely no drugs, alcohol, tobacco products, knives, or firearms.
- Absolutely No Fighting.
- Horses will **NOT** be provided for any of the rodeo timed events. Horses **MAY** be provided for the Basic Horsemanship. If you desire to participate in a rodeo timed event, it is your responsibility to find a mount. If you are borrowing another Camper's horse, it must be approved by the Instructor for that particular timed event.

Camp will end following the presentation of ALL awards on the last day, after the rodeo. Campers will not be released until the awards ceremony is over. Due to the potential number of Campers, please plan to stay awhile and honor all of them.
